Bull Development Program:

Calves are weaned from 150 days to 245 days depending on available pasture conditions with no creep. At weaning, bulls start on 5lbs per head per day of grain while on pasture or hay. This ration is increased to 10lbs per head per day and are never fully fed so they are grown slowly to reach maximum development under pasture conditions. Breeding soundness exams are performed at 14 months of age.

Vaccination Program:

1. Calvary 9 @ 45 days with booster at weaning.
2. Cattle Master 4 + VL5 4 weeks prior to weaning and booster at weaning.
3. Wormed with Safeguard Drench at weaning and again 90 days later.
